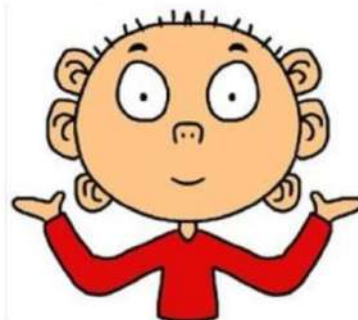


IDIOM OF THE DAY

Meaning:

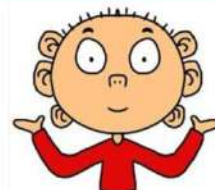
- To listen very carefully and attentively.
