Meaning:

to accept criticism, responsibility, or punishment for something you have done

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Sample sentences:

1. He knew he had to **face the music** after missing the deadline.
2. It's better to admit your mistake and **face the music** now.
3. She finally **faced the music** and apologised for her behaviour.
4. If you break the rules, you must **face the music**.
5. The company will have to **face the music** for its poor decisions.
