

IDIOM OF THE DAY



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Meaning:

To fail to understand the main idea or the most important part of what someone is saying.

Sample sentences:

1. I think you've **missed the point** of the story; it's about love, not money.
2. Stop worrying about the font size; you're **missing the point** of the assignment!
3. I'm sorry, I think **I missed the point**—could you explain that again?
4. She **missed the point** entirely when I tried to tell her I was joking.
5. The teacher repeated the explanation because some students **missed the point**.
